Annexure to Government Order No. 99 - JK(IND) of 2023

Dated 06.04.2023

In the Procedural Guidelines to the Jammu and Kashmir Industrial Policy, 2021-30;

(i) after clause 6.2, the following clause shall be added; namely: -

"6.3 The concerned Director, Industries and Commerce Department on the recommendations of the Managing Director, J&K, SIDCO/SICOP shall be the approving authority for allowing any change in Name and Style at the Pre-registration stage, subject to the following conditions in relation to revision of DPRs:

- i. That there is no upward/ downward revision of the allotted land and it shall remain a constant factor. Under no circumstances revision of DPR should lead to a requirement for allotment of additional land.
- ii. The merit of the allottee on the basis of which land allotment was done shall not be affected adversely by the permissible change in the DPR post allotment.
- iii. The change in DPR shall not downgrade the criteria of merit as in point 2 above, or bring in any drop in the investment/ kanal and employment/ kanal based on which land was allotted."

(ii) after clause 8.4, the following clause shall be added; namely:

"8.5. The Managing Director, J&K SIDCO / SICOP on the recommendation of the concerned Director, Industries & Commerce Department shall be the approving authority for allowing any change in line of activity/ additional line of activity at the Pre-registration stage, subject to the following conditions in relation to revision of DPRs:

- i. That there is no upward/ downward revision of the allotted land and it shall remain a constant factor. Under no circumstances revision of DPR should lead to a requirement for allotment of additional land.
- ii. The merit on the basis of which land allotment was done shall not be affected adversely by the permissible change in the DPR post allotment.
- iii. The change in DPR shall not downgrade the criteria of merit as in point 2 above, or bring in any drop in the investment/ kanal and employment/ kanal based on which land was allotted."
